Primeiros passos no c:geo



Para utilizar o c:geo, será necessário uma conta numa plataforma geocaching. Neste momento, o c:geo suporta o [geocaching.com](https://www.geocaching.com), uma plataforma comercial internacional, assim como plataformas Opencaching em diversos países (por exemplo, [Opencaching USA](https://www.opencaching.com), [Opencaching UK](https://www.opencaching.com) e muitas mais). Selecione a plataforma que pretende usar e crie uma conta na sua página (Contas basicas normalmente são gratuitas).

Sem uma conta numa destas plataformas de geocaching o c:geo não irá funcionar!

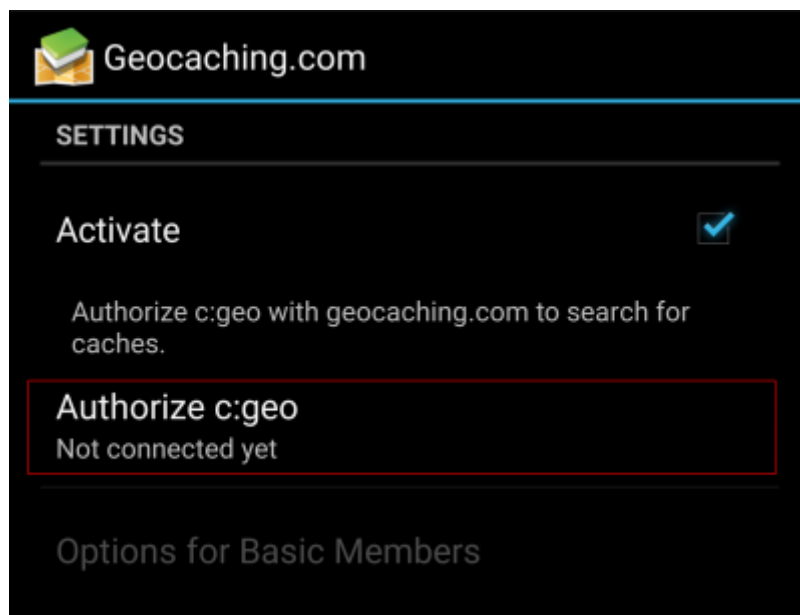
Registering c:geo with geocaching.com

If you start c:geo for the first time after installation, you will be directly taken to the service settings where you can enter your username and password for geocaching.com.

If you would like to access the service settings for geocaching.com again after the first start, you will find them in:


Menu → Settings → Services → geocaching.com

Click on the button Authorize c:geo as shown below::




After clicking on Authorize c:geo a window will be shown, where you can enter your username and password for geocaching.com and finally click on Check authentication.

If you do not yet have an account, you may click on the button Create an account to open the registration page of geocaching.com.

Registering c:geo with Opencaching platforms

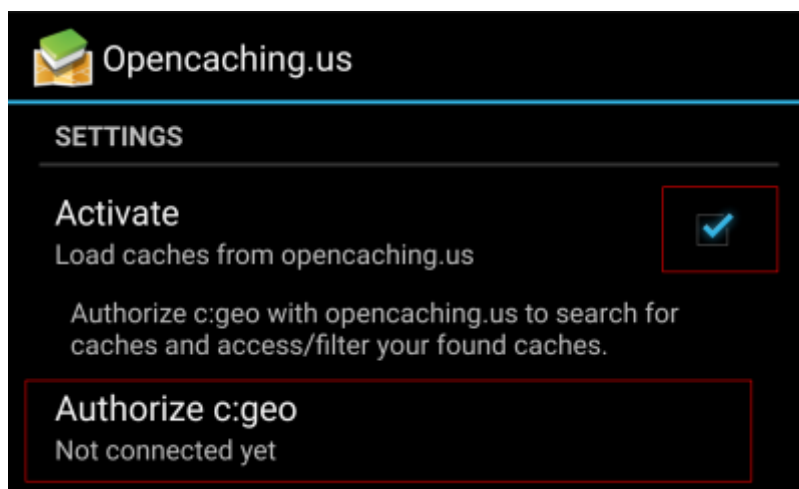
If you want to connect c:geo with another service than geocaching.com or re-access the service settings, you will find them in:

Menu → Settings → Services

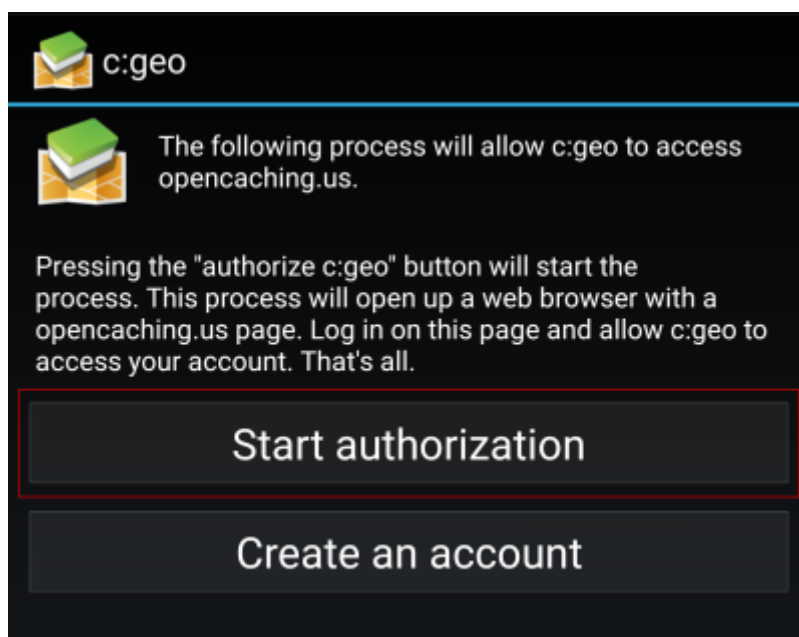

and Start authorization in the next screen. If you do not yet have an account, you may click on the button Create an account to open the registration page of the Opencaching platform.


